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Milas, once the capital of the ancient Kingdom of Caria, is a pleasant Aegean town which is famous and historically important part of Mugla province. Old town and old houses, lively market and town shopping center with many small local shops are must to see. Town is also known for its world famous Milas carpets.

In and around town of Milas there are no less than 27 different Ancients sites.

Old Milas Houses are a must to see starting with 19 and 20 century houses massive protection / renovation is in progress. In town center you can visit Milas museum, Çöllüoğlu Hanı and historical mosques (14th-century mosques, built when Milas was capital of the Menteşe emirate. These include the Great Mosque (Ulu Cami, 1378), the Mosque of Orhan Bey (1330), and the Firuz Bey Mosque (1394))Beçin Castle, Çomakdağ,

Gümüşkesen temple (a miniature replica of the grand, original Mausoleum, one of the Seven Wonders of the World) and also the Baltalı Kapı (Gate with Axe- a Roman gate in the city walls). Also visit some of the town's 14th-century mosques, built when Milas was capital of the Menteşe emirate. These include the Great Mosque (Ulu Cami, 1378), the Mosque of Orhan Bey (1330), and the Firuz Bey Mosque (1394).

Up in the hills north of Milas is the ancient city of Labranda.

Euromos ancient city, İasos and Herakleia ancient cities are important places to visit.

Bafa Lake which was a bay and part of sea has become a lake with the help of meandros rivers alluvions. There is a very small island monastry can be seen at the lake side used by early Christian monks.

The excursion will take you through unspoilt and undiscovered treasures of the region like Iasos (Iasos is built on a peninsula surrounded on its three sides by the sea in Kıyıkıslacık Koyu which is 28 km away from Milas.)

Popular holiday places, like Bodrum, Ören and Didim, are nearby Milas



Milas is an ancient city and the seat of the district of the same name in Muğla Province in southwestern Turkey. The city commands a region with an active economy, and the region is very rich in history and its remains, the whole territory of Milas district containing a remarkable twenty-seven archaeological sites of note. The city was the first capital of ancient Caria and of the Anatolian beylik of Menteşe in medieval times. The centre of Milas presents the overall characteristics of a well-grown city focused on agricultural and aquacultural processing, related industrial activities, services, transportation (particularly since the opening of Milas-Bodrum International Airport), tourism and culture. The center is at a distance of about twenty km from the coast and is actually closer to the airport than Bodrum itself, with many late arrival passengers of the high season increasingly opting to stay in Milas rather than in Bodrum where accommodation is likely to be difficult to find.
